# "CELEBRATING WOMEN"


Saturday November 7 12:30pm – 3:00pm.



#### Read with Me 2020-2021

Read with Me is moving ahead in 2020. This year instruction and tutoring will be done remotely via computer. Our students at Saul Martinez have now received iPads and wifi hotspots have been set up to cover all areas Read with Met served by the Coachella Valley School district.

Our volunteers have two ways to interact with their teachers and students. They can do so during regular class hours 8:30am - 12:00pm per special arrangements with the teachers. There is also a special time when students and volunteers "meet" outside regular class hours,12:05pm-1:00pm, with an option to meet until 2:00pm at the teacher's discretion.

Training and computers will be available at Hope on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. There will be an instructor on site and extra iPads, if needed. The training will be held in the Overflow Room, with appropriate social distancing, there will be room for 12 volunteers and the instructor. In the future volunteers will also be able to get online with the students during the prescribed hours. Eventually, volunteers will be able to connect with their students from home.

The kids at Saul Martinez need us now more than ever. They miss the personal interaction with friends, classmates, their teachers and volunteers.
